### A Bill to Confirm 'The Liturgies of the Word Amendment Statute, 2022'

#### Whereas:

- (a) The General Synod/Te Hīnota Whānui 2022 enacted as Statute number 767 'The Liturgies of the Word Amendment Statute, 2022,' in terms of Part B, Clause 6a of the Constitution/te Pouhere, and Section 4a of the Church of England Empowering Act 1928 to authorise amendments to the Formularies, and
- (b) Te Rūnanganui o Te Pīhopatanga o Aotearoa, the Synod of the Diocese of Polynesia, and a majority of the Diocesan Synods in New Zealand have assented to the proposal pursuant to Part B, Clause 6b of the Constitution/te Pouhere, and Section 4b of the Church of England Empowering Act 1928, and
- (c) Since the adoption of this proposal, there has been a fresh election of members of the General Synod/te Hīnota Whānui, in fulfillment of Part B, Clause 6c of the Constitution/ te Pouhere.

#### The General Synod/Te Hīnota Whānui enacts as follows:

- **1. Title.** The Title of this Statute shall be *The Liturgies of the Word Amendment Confirmation Statute, 2024.*
- **2.** The proposal contained in Statute 767 to Amend 'The Liturgies of the Word,' is agreed to as follows:

Or

Glory to God, Source of all being, Eternal Word, and Holy Spirit;\* as it was in the beginning, is now, and shall be for ever. Amen.

Glory to God, Source of all being, Incarnate Word, and Holy Spirit,\* as it was in the beginning, is now and will be forever. Amen.

Or

Glory to the holy and undivided Trinity, one God: as it was in the beginning, is now and will be forever. Amen.

Or

Glory to the Trinity, the only God, for ever and ever.
