- 4. An approachable, visible, and collaborative professional

- 6. Hard working, self-disciplined, and able to work independently under pressure and to tight deadlines
- 7. Able to deal with professionally and personally sensitive issues with empathy, discretion and confidentiality
- 8. Excellent communicator and educator, confident and culturally aware.
- 9. Technologically astute
- 10. Patient and diplomatic in dealings with people and key stakeholders
- 11. Able to recognise and utilise the best attributes of those around them
- 12. Able to manage a team and be confident delegating tasks appropriately
